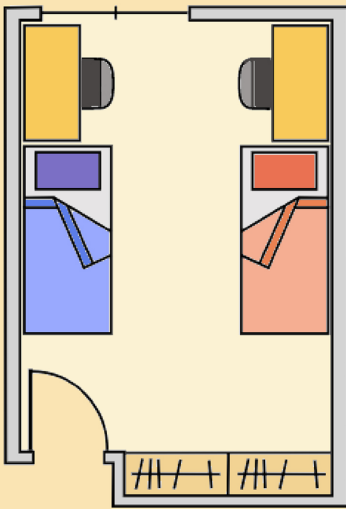
ROOM Layout

Bring a wifi router and/or LAN/Ethernet cable for internet connection in your own room! Network points are under study desks.

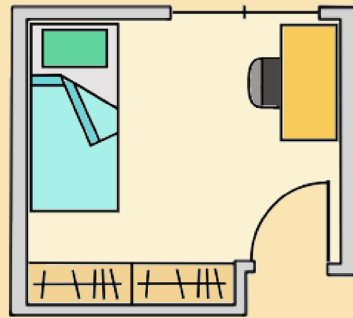

3 ASSASSINATION

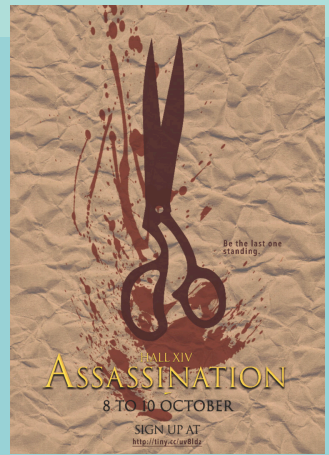
