1.	<p><b><u>1.1 Proposal for Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen to be Present and have Speaking Rights</u></b> Proposer: Ms Er Joey Secunder: Ms Looi Hui Jun</p> <p><b><u>1.2 Proposal to Proceed to First Agenda</u></b> Proposer: Ms Violin Yapputri Secunder: Ms Cheah Guan Ying</p> <p>Joel, the Council Chairperson, explained that the agenda was to appoint a non-council member into the position of Housing Policy Executive of the 30<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee. Once elected, he would become a council member with full speaking right, but without any voting rights.</p> <p><b><u>1.3 Housing Policy Executive Rally</u></b> Co-opted Executive for Housing Policy Executive: Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) Proposer: Mr Timothy Yip Secunder: Ms Ng May Lin</p> <p><b><u>1.3.1 Presentation</u></b> Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) shares that he is a Year 3 Psychology student. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) then shares his previous leadership positions, where he was the Vice-President (Programmes and Logistics) in Union Orientation, and was CCGL for Meranti Hall Orientation. He then mentions his personal experience on hall applications, where he used 3 different ways to get his hall allocation throughout his NTU life. He aims to integrate of NTU students into the university via housing. He hopes to make policy changes, that would allow hall accommodations to be a reliable, comfortable and safe space for students. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) then mentions the stakeholders that are involved with his role. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) then shares his vision for all hall policies. He wishes to make hall policies fair, by standardization of campus life points across all student organizations. He also wishes for hall allocation to have greater transparency, via more timely notifications of school policy changes and to make relevant statistics for hall to be widely available to students. Lastly, he wishes for greater relevance of hall policies, by communicating the students' concern of hall policies more clearly. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) mentions his some of his plans, which include plans of semester 2 hall allocation and plans on the upcoming Jurong Regional Line.</p> <p><b><u>1.3.2 Question and Answer</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ms Lim Gia Lim asks how Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) wants to work towards change of the semester 2 hall allocation, and how Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) would like to ensure hall policy information to be disseminated on time.</li> <li>Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) says he hopes to work on communication, where information can be released on NTUSU website. He hopes to tap on other alternative platforms to communicate such policy changes, and work on 2-way communication, such as improved communications with Hall Councils. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) wants to work on reopening of hall allocation for semester 2. He mentions that, to his knowledge, there is no semester 2 reopening of hall allocation. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) mentions about the need for a semester 2 hall allocation, especially in view of the COVID-19 situation, where many students opted out of hall stay due to the mass of classes being online. Mr Tneoh Yuan Chen (Kenji) also mentions that he hopes to use previous years' campus life points for students applying for semester 2.</li> </ul>

She shares her core values, which encompasses growth, dedication and compassion. She then shares multiple relevant experiences, which include being a communications intern in various companies and being a marketing intern in both Singapore and Dubai. She was also a publicity director in the Student Integration Committee, in the 29<sup>th</sup> NTUSU. Ms Amarpreet Kaur then shares that she wants to take on the role as the Integration Executive, as she wants to advocate for a cause that she is passionate about.
