#### 4.2 Election Workgroup Updates

- Mr Leonard Chan Jun Wei presented the progress made on the E Voting system.
- Mr Leonard Chan Jun Wei presented the details of the E Voting system as was presented to the 25<sup>th</sup> council.
- Mr Gan Rui Yun gave the background to how the E Voting system started in the 24<sup>th</sup> council to increase voter turnout. This was also a result of the EEE elections in 2014.
- The 25<sup>th</sup> council established the system but required time to finalise the wordings of the regulations and so this was pushed to the 26<sup>th</sup> council due to the summer break recess.
- The 25<sup>th</sup> council firmed up the wordings for paper voting as a failsafe for if E Voting fails.
- Mr Gan Rui Yun said that they need to pass the regulations and test the system, elect the Chief Returning Officer and 2 election officers who will facilitate the elections.
- Concerns were raised on the timeframe of the E Voting preparations, the backup system preparations and the elections date.
